- Treasury's Report: Balance is \$1832.19 in the EICC bank account. Two checks were issued to the Pride for EICC advertising. Kathleen is looking into the service charge that the bank is charging to the EICC bank account.

- Committee Reports -

- Membership: Bill Gartland got some information on window decals for members. For 500 decals it cost \$250, that's only for one color. Bill is going to look into the cost for two colors.
- Website: Still need a few photos for the directors to put up on the website. Ryan and Stephen will be going over the website. Some things to review include the organizations that we have posted and some additional contact information. If all members could review the website and make suggestions it would be appreciated.
- Activities: Mike Visgauss is looking into banners to post at EICC events. We are able to fundraise because the 1023 form is being processed. The cell phone drive comes to an end

this month and Lora Rosenthal is working with Mark Hannigan to plan a PR event for the drive. Several judges and attorneys will be attending the presentation.

Bill Gartland along with a few other members met with somebody from the East Islip Lanes regarding having a fundraiser at the bowling alley. 250 people/at \$15.00 a person/ includes 2 games. It was suggested to have the fundraiser in July or August.

Some other fundraising suggestions include a blood drive or a car wash at Rita's. Rita's schedule fills up fast so that would need to be planned ASAP.

- Public Relations: Mark Hannigan is reviewing advertising with Star Publishing Group. Russ Regan has looked into getting trinkets and shirts for EICC events. 5 dozen shirts/ one color/ cost \$450.00. 4-6 dozen polo shirts/one color would cost \$10-\$12 a shirt. The EICC will continue to run ads in the Pride.
- Notes:
